A profiling and diagnostics tools suite for HotSpot

- Production time profiling and diagnostics
- Low overhead
 - Using already available runtime information
- Client available as a stand alone application & Eclipse plug-ins
 - *Built in GUI editor for easy customization (not supported yet)*

- Management Console
 - One of the best JMX Consoles available
 - Use for monitoring
- Flight Recorder
 - High performance JVM event recorder
 - Use for diagnostics, profiling
- More tools as downloadable addons

- Event Recorder
 - Different types of events
 - Duration Event, Instant Event, Requestable Event
 - Java and JVM events produced by the JDK
 - 3rdparty events - Weblogic, Glassfish, add your own as well!
- Low Overhead
 - Use in production

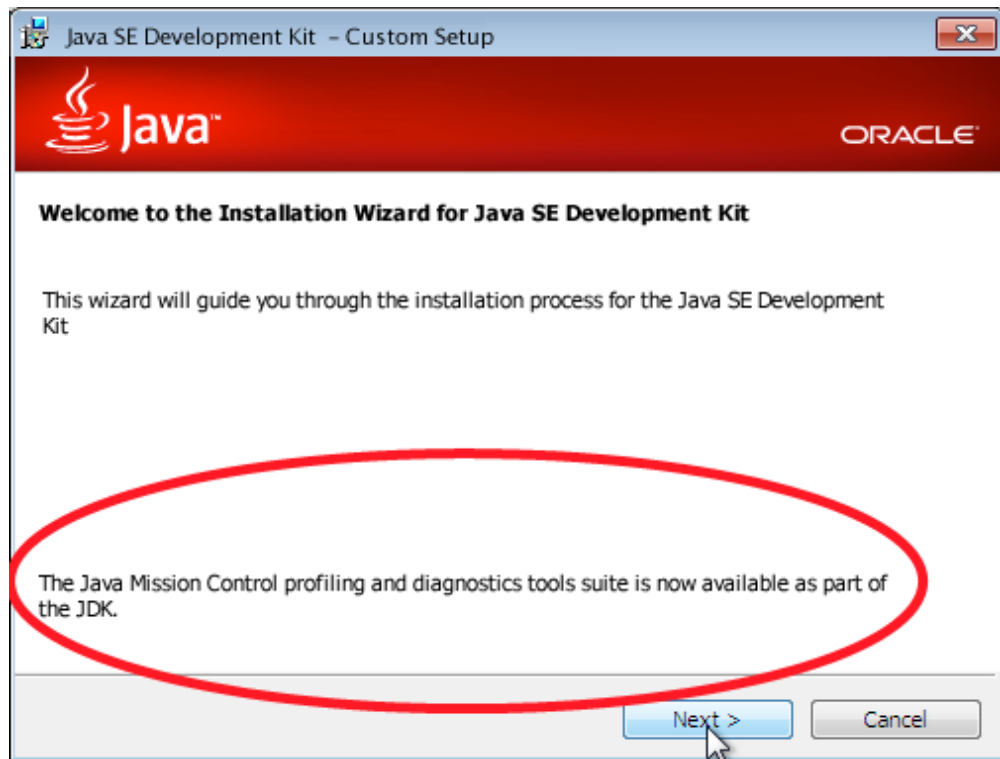

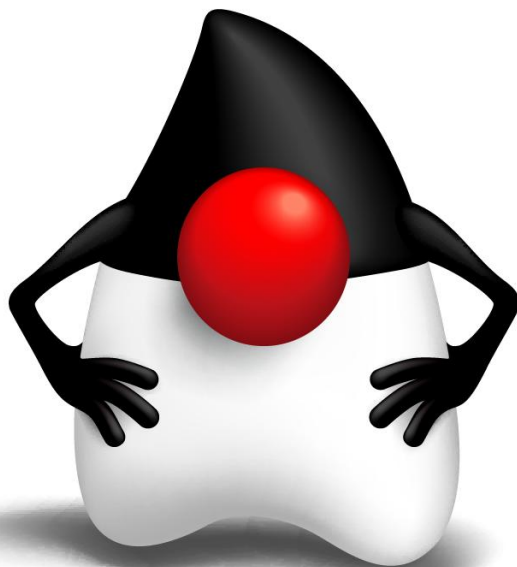
