The Issue's - 1

- No standardization of the XMLHttpRequest yet
 - Future version of IE (v8) will address this
- No support of XMLHttpRequest in old browsers
 - IFrame will help
 - Testing on different browsers and Operating Systems
- Back button challenge and history support
- Security (validation!)

The Issue's - 2

- JavaScript technology dependency & incompatibility
 - Must be enabled for applications to function
 - Browser incompatibilities (+ CSS)
- The many JavaScript files
 - First externalize JS and then compress to one file!
- No Rich Media support
 - The JavaScript Canvas object however looks promising...

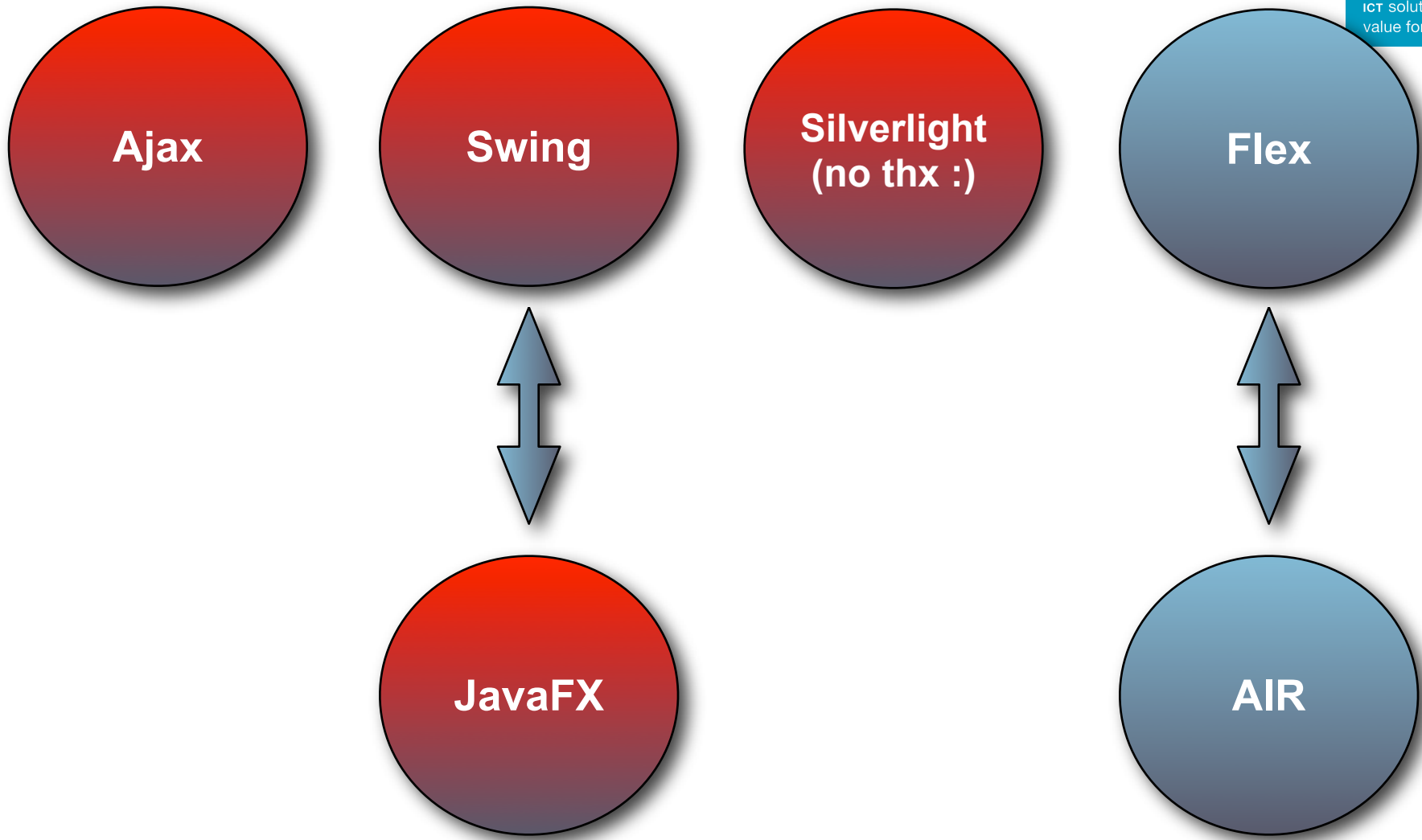

My RIA Options ?



Why Flex ?

- Has an offline (AIR) and online (Flex) strategy
- Works great with Java (EE) back end
- Supports HTTP Rest calls using JSON/XML for binding
- Video and Audio support is the best out there !!
- Uses Eclipse plugin (Flex builder) for development

My issues with Flex

- How can I leverage the Java expertise ?
- Can I test my ActionScript code ?
- Can I resolve my web 2.0 / AJAX issues ?
 - Back button
 - Bookmarking
 - Cross browser support
 - ...

- We know our Java (EE) design patterns
 - Business Delegate
 - Value / Transferable Objects
 - Front Controller
 - Command Pattern
 - Service Locator
 - Data Access Objects (DAO)
 - ORM (Hibernate -> JPA)
- So lets use Cairngorm
 - Introduces known (Java) design patterns in Flex

Cairngorm

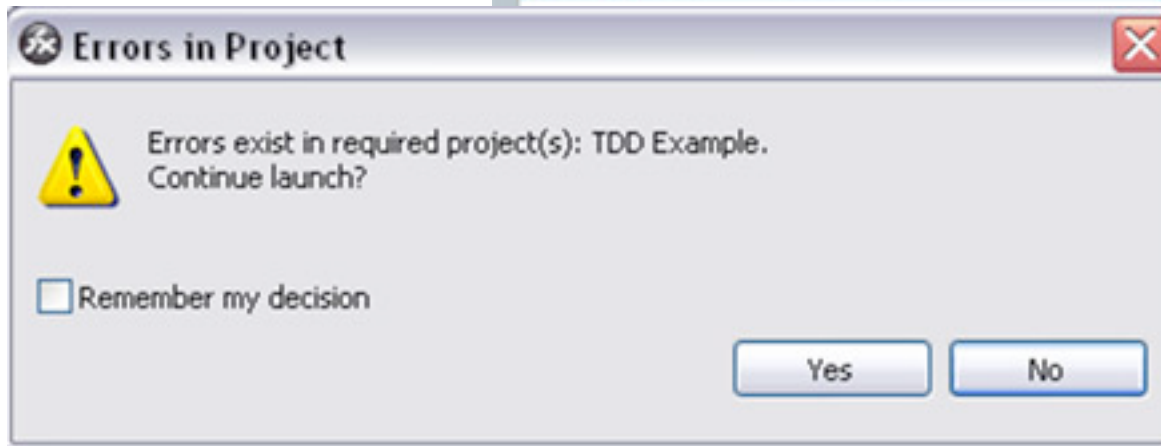
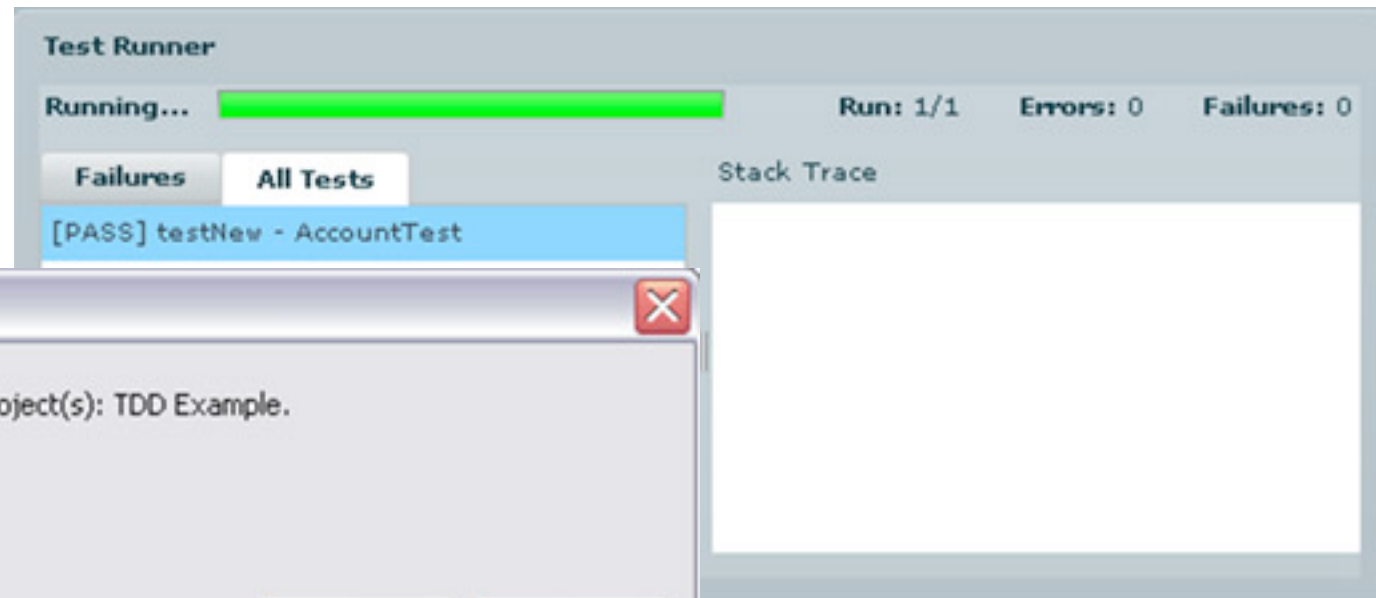
- Cairngorm is a lightweight framework for RIA development
- Is based on existing enterprise software design patterns from Java
- Follows the Model View Controller (MVC) design
- Introduces separation of concerns within your development team

Flex Opportunities - 1

- Annotations support within ActionScript
 - ActionScript metadata might do the trick
 - Have a lightweight JPA implementation in ActionScript :)
- Aspect Oriented Development (AOP)
 - Around Advice (Interceptors) techniques for further modularization
- Inversion of Control (IoC) support
 - Also know as Dependency Injection...
 - Exists more or less using Bindable and MXML :)

Test Driven Development

- ActionScript Unit tests can be developed
 - AS2Unit
 - a free Unit Testing Framework for ActionScript 2
 - FlexUnit



Flex Opportunities - 2

- How can Google index my content ?
 - Some blogs are starting to discuss this...
- What about functional testing Flex apps like Selenium
 - First initiatives are appearing FunFX (v0.0.1), Mercury QuickTest, Borland (formerly Segue), ...
- What about ActionScript code audit like FindBugs, CheckStyle, ...
 - Do we have AST parsers, maybe when Flex is open-sourced...
- Bundling of ActionScript modules using OSGi ?
